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History of the Two Thousand Hail Mary's Devotion

It was in 1933, I, Monsignor Juan Riu Farran, was fifteen and a half years of age: I was studying in the Salesian Seminary of San Vicente of the Horts, near the City of Barcelona. Around the 25th of March, 1933, one of my Seminary companions, Daniel Ara, of the Province of Huesca, in Aragon, said to me:

“Riu, I have something interesting to tell to you: There is a pious belief, that whoever prays two thousand Hail Mary's on the 25th of Mary, the Feast of the Incarnation of the Son of God, obtains from the Blessed Virgin Mary, at least three graces.”

That information was imbedded deeply in my mind, and when the day of the 25th of March arrived, I prayed with much devotion the Two Thousand Hail Mary's, requesting of the Blessed Virgin Mary, three graces: To be Salesian, To be a Priest, and to be a Missionary. And I confidently awaited in the fulfillment of the promise of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

On the 16th of July, 1935, after serving in Holy Mass, my companion, Daniel Ara, and I went on an excursion or stroll by the forests and hills not far from the city of Gerona; where we were doing the Novitiate, in preparation for the Religious Salesian Profession.

Towards the middle of the day when we reunited with our Superiors, who accompanied us in the excursion, communicated to us the sad news that my companion Daniel Ara, when trying to jump a brook, lost his balance and fell into the water and drowned.

On the 17th, a memorable day, at ten o'clock in the morning, we began the spiritual exercises in preparation for the religious profession, that took place the 27th of July. At that moment, I realized that the First Grace requested on the 25th of March, 1933, to be a Salesian was fulfilled.

In July 18, 1936, the Spanish revolution and persecution exploded, in which we had to leave the Seminary running the risk to be captured and assassinated; as it happened with hundreds of thousands. These were hard and difficult years.

The Spanish Civil War finally ended on the 1st of April, 1939, with the defeat of Spanish Communists, by the troops of General Franco. We were able to return to our Religious Houses to continue our studies in preparation for the priesthood.

On the 15th of June, 1946, in the Seminary Chapel of Madrid, I was ordained a priest together with twenty Salesian companions, by the Bishop of Madrid, Monsignors Leopoldo Eijo and Garay. The second grace, requested on the 25th of March, 1933, had been fulfilled.

On the 30th of August, 1952, I arrived in San Juan, Puerto Rico, to begin my apostolic missionary work in the poorest district of San Juan. And the third grace request on March 25, 1933, became a reality: To be a Missionary.

After eleven long years of missionary work in Puerto Rico, I was invited by Bishop Monsignor Jose Felix Pintado, to help him in the Easter Salesian Missions of Ecuador, considered like watering a dry tree. From December 4, 1964 to the present day, the Blessed Virgin Mary had fulfilled her promises.

Today, the Devotion of the Two Thousand Hail Mary's has spread to many countries, thanks to the Marian devotion and fervor of the Philippine people.

Opening Prayers

Blessed be the Holy Trinity, One God, now and forever. Amen. Glory be to the Father, Who created me; glory be to the Son, Who redeemed me; glory be to the Holy Spirit, Who sanctifies me. We pray and implore the Holy Spirit to come down and bestow upon us His holy gifts, so that we will be inflamed with the power and fire of His love.

And, once again, we gather ourselves together before You, Dearest Blessed Mother, to pray for all your intentions. We know that you will bring our humble prayers, together with yours, before the Throne of God and Your Beloved Son; and that, in your loving hands, you will disperse of them. For you know best to apply them where they are needed most.

Consecration to the Holy Spirit

On my knees before the great multitude of Heavenly witnesses, I offer myself: soul and body to You, Eternal Spirit of God. I adore the brightness of Your purity, the unerring keenness of Your justice and the might of Your love. You are the strength and light of my soul. In You, I live and move and am. I desire never to grieve You by unfaithfulness to grace and, I pray with all my heart to be kept from the smallest sin against You.

Mercifully guard my every thought and grant that I may always watch for Your light and listen to Your Voice and follow Your gracious inspirations. I cling to You and give myself to You and ask You by Your compassion to watch over me in my weakness. Holding the pierce feet of Jesus and looking at His five wounds and trusting in His Precious Blood and adoring His opened Side and stricken Heart; I implore You Adorable Spirit, Helper of my infirmity, so to keep me in Your grace that I may never sin against You. Give me grace, O Holy Spirit, Spirit of the Father and the Son to say to You always and everywhere:

“Speak Lord, for your sinful servant is listening.” Amen.

Consecration To The Sacred Heart of Jesus

Most Sweet Jesus, Redeemer of the human race, look down upon us humbly prostrate before Your altar. We are Yours and Yours we wish to be. To be more surely united with You, behold we freely consecrate ourselves today to Your Most Sacred Heart. Many indeed have never know You. Many too, despising Your precepts, have rejected You. Have mercy on them all, most Merciful Jesus, and draw them to Your Sacred Heart.

Be King, O Lord, not only of the faithful who have never forsaken You, but also for the prodigal children who have abandoned You. Grant that they may quickly return to their Fathers’ house, lest they die of wretchedness and hunger. Be King of those who are deceived by erroneous opinions, or whom discord keeps them aloof, and call them back to the harbor of truth and unity of faith, so that soon there may be but one flock and one Shepherd.

Grant, O Lord, to Your Church, assurance of freedom and immunity from harm. Give peace and order to all nations, and make the earth resound from pole to pole with one cry: ***Praise to the Divine Heart that wrought our salvation; to Him be glory and honor forever. Amen.***

Consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary

Virgin of Fatima, Mother of Mercy, Queen of Heaven and Earth, refuge of sinners, we who belong to the Marian Movement consecrate ourselves in a very special way to your Immaculate Heart.

By this act of consecration, we intend to live with you, and through you, all the obligations assumed by our baptismal consecration. We further pledge to bring about in ourselves that interior conversion so urgently demanded by the Gospel. A conversion that will free us of every attachment to ourselves, to easy compromises with the world so that, we may be available only to do always the will of the Father. And as we resolve to entrust you, O Mother most sweet and merciful, our life and vocation as Christians; that you may dispose of it according to your designs of salvation in this hour of decision that weights upon the world.

We pledge to live it according to your desires, especially as it pertains to a renewed spirit of prayer and penance, the fervent participation in the celebration of the Eucharist and in the works of the apostolate, the daily recitation of the Holy Rosary, and an austere manner of life in keeping with the Gospel, that shall be to all a good example of the observances of the Law of God and the practice of the Christian virtues, especially that of purity.

We further promise you, to be united with the Holy Father, with the hierarchy and with our priests; in order, thus, to set up a barrier to the growing confrontations directed against the Magisterium, that threatens the very foundation of the Church. Under your protection, we want, moreover, to be apostles of this sorely needed unity of prayer and love for the Pope, on whom we invoke your special protection. And lastly, insofar as is possible, we promise to lead those souls with whom we come in contact, to a renewed devotion to you.

Mindful that Atheism has caused shipwreck in the faith to a great number of the faithful, that desecration has entered into the holy Temple of God, and that evil and sin are spreading more and more throughout the world. We make so bold as to lift our eyes trustingly to you, O Mother of Jesus, and our merciful and powerful Mother, and we invoke again today and await from you the salvation of all your children: O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary. Amen.

Consecration to St. Joseph

O dearest St. Joseph, I consecrate myself to your honor and give myself to you that you may always be my father, my protector, and my guide in the way of salvation. Obtain for me a great purity of heart and a fervent love of the interior life. After your example, may I do all my actions for the greater glory of God in union with the Divine Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary. O blessed St. Joseph, pray for me that I may share in the peace and joy of your holy death. Amen.

Prayer to St. Michael, the Archangel

St. Michael, the Archangel, defend us on the day of the Battle: be our safeguard against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray, and do Thou, O prince of the Heavenly Host, by the power of God, cast into hell, Satan and all the other evil spirits, who prowl through the world, seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.

The Angelus

V. The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary.

R. And she conceived of the Holy Spirit. Hail Mary ...
V. Behold the handmaid of the Lord.
R. Be it done unto me according to thy word. Hail Mary ...
V. And the Word was made flesh, (kneel down)
R. And dwelt among us. (stand up) Hail Mary ...
V. Pray for us, O holy Mother of God,
R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let us pray: Pour forth, we beseech Thee, O Lord, Thy grace into our hearts. that we to whom the Incarnation of Christ, Thy Son, was made known by the message of an Angel, may by His Passion and Cross be brought to the glory of His Resurrection; through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.

Memorare of St. Bernard

Remember, O most gracious Virgin Mary, that never was it known; that anyone who fled to your protection, implored your help or sought your intercession, was left unaided. Inspired with this confidence, I fly unto you, O Virgin of Virgins, my Mother! To you I come, before you I stand, sinful and sorrowful. O Mother of the Word Incarnate, despise not my petitions but in your mercy, hear and answer them. Amen.

Chaplet of Divine Mercy

You died Jesus, but the source of life flowed out for souls and the ocean of Mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fountain of Life, immeasurable Divine Mercy, cover the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us. O Blood and Water which flowed out from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of mercy for us, I trust in You.

Begin Chaplet with: Our Father, Hail Mary, I believe in God,

(Large beads recite)

V. Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ:
R. In atonement for our sins and the sins of the whole world.

(Small beads recite 10 times)

V. For the sake of His sorrowful Passion,
R. Have mercy on us and on the whole world.

(Closing Prayer)

V. Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One,
R. Have mercy on us and on the whole world. (recite 3 times)

Jesus, King of Divine Mercy, we trust in You. Amen.

Prayer of the Two Thousand Hail Mary's

Begin with saying the Petition and then recite one (1) Our Father and fifty (50) Hail Mary's.

Petition 1: We pray for the grace of prayer.

It is our dialogue and communion with God. Teach us how to cultivate and experience the power of prayer in ourselves. Give us the grace to pray in every opportunity we have and uplift every task that we do as a prayer which we offer to Jesus. Let us remember what our Mother Mary said, "That God has chosen to use us in His great plan of salvation of mankind." So let us pray, not only for ourselves but for all mankind, particularly for the conversion of those who are not now in God's grace. (Recite 50 Hail Mary's)

Petition 2: We pray for peace.

Let us begin within us, and from us, so that we in turn, may spread peace in the world to all mankind. Heal us of our faults and weaknesses and let us realize that if we want to be cleansed and be healed, we must first have total forgiveness and love in our hearts. Let us not dwell in things that are not of God, like anger, pride, envy, and selfishness. But instead, pour in our hearts, through the Holy Spirit, the gift of love, humility, patience, forgiveness and understanding. It is only through dying to one's "self" that we can truly have peace. Amen. (Recite 50 Hail Mary's)

Petition 3: We pray for the conversion of sinners.

We pray for the conversion of sinners, the unbelievers and for all the spiritually poor, so that they will be filled with the love of God. Let men turn against sin and against the enemy. Give the grace of going back to Jesus by touching the hearts of sinners, and especially the hearts of those who have left the Catholic Church to join other sects and beliefs. We pray for the conversion of Atheists, the Pagans, the Jews, and the Moslems. We invoke the Holy Spirit to enlighten the minds of the Heretics and Schismatic's, and to revive in the hearts of lukewarm souls the fervor and love of God (Recite 50 Hail Mary's)

Petition 4: We pray for the prevention of abortion.

Dear God, let this horrible crime stop! Let all who contemplate an abortion, fully understand that the unborn child is a human being who has a soul and killing the unborn is grievous, mortal offense against God, the Creator of Life. Let Your grace fall upon all people so that they will respect, defend and uphold the Sanctity of Life, not only of the unborn: but of the aged, dying, the handicapped, and the unwanted, as well. Also, let the confused, who are on the verge of committing suicide; very carefully weigh in the minds God's Fifth Commandment: "Thou Shalt Not Kill" and avoid this serious sin against God. (Recite 50 Hail Mary's)

Petition 5: We pray for all addictions.

We pray for those who are in any form of addiction that disrupts family relationships. Those addicted to alcohol and drugs, those addicted in the flesh, or addicted in any kind of vice. Touch them, O Mother Mary, and free them from the snares of Satan, who now envelop them. Bring them back, reunite and heal the families that have been broken and break instead these evil influences that destroy families. (Recite 50 Hail Mary's)

Petition 6: We pray for the Holy Mass.

We pray for the grace to know and appreciate the importance and value of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and pray for an increased frequency in the reception of the Sacraments of Penance and the Holy Eucharist. May every prayer and spiritual work we do lead us to the Holy Mass, because the Holy Mass is the highest form of prayer and the greatest offering for the reparation of sins, and Jesus is there. His undying love for mankind manifested as He relives His sacrifice in Calvary to save us. May these Sacraments renew us each

day, and strengthen us spiritually in our crusade to serve Jesus and Mother Mary, in spreading their messages to whomever we talk and see. (Recite 50 Hail Mary's)

Petition 7: We pray for more Vocations.

Please put into the hearts of young people, the awareness of service to God, through the increase in vocations. Let parents encourage their children and give them an upbringing filled with an awareness of their blessed state in life. Bless all Seminarians who are now studying and preparing themselves to the Priesthood. Strengthen them and give them perseverance. Guide them and guard them for they belong to You, Lord Jesus. (50 Hail Mary's)

Petition 8: We pray for the grace of the daily reading of the Holy Bible.

Teach us the daily reading of the Holy Bible and spiritual books because God, Himself, talks to us when we read the Scriptures of His life, His teachings and His holy words in the Bible. May the Holy Spirit enlighten our minds and give us the grace to live the Gospel, and to put into practice all that we have read of the words and ways of Our Lord Jesus, in our daily life. In essence, to imitate Jesus and live the Word.

Petition 9: We pray for the Pope.

We pray for Pope _____, the visible representative of Christ in the Church and the successor of Peter. Only in Peter, has Christ built His Church. So, with the faith of Peter, in these times of greatest darkness and apostasy; let us pray for support and protection of the Vicar of Christ, the Pope. May Priests and Bishops remain loyal to the true faith through their obedience to the Pope, preach loudly in word and example what Jesus Himself has instructed Peter to be, the foundation of His Church and the irreproachable presence of the Truth, and may they remain united with the Pope and help him carry his large Cross to Calvary.

Petition 10: We pray for more prayer groups.

We pray for the increase of prayer groups and cenacles. May we have the grace to live the messages of Mother Mary in our hearts. That we may give examples by living them in our daily lives, so that we may in turn work and inspire the formation of more prayer groups. Bless and protect the prayer groups and cenacles from disunity and discord, but rather bestow upon them your special graces, in love and unity.

Petition 11: We pray to accept our own cross.

We pray for the acceptance of our own cross, and abandon ourselves completely to Jesus Christ and His Divine will, as He, Himself, said: "If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me." (*St. Matt. 16:24*) For whoever picks up his cross and looks back, is not worthy to follow Me. So, whatever trials and sufferings we encounter, may we offer them to Jesus and not be afraid because His is with us, when we put our faith, trust and confidence in Him.

Petition 12: We pray for deliverance from enemy.

We pray for our deliverance from the enemy, the devil. Mother Mary, please rescue us the moment Satan or any other evil spirit tries to tempt us to fall into sin and deliver us from all distractions that pull us away from the path that leads to you and Jesus. Grant us the wisdom to discern, so that we will be able to distinguish right from wrong, good from evil. You have obtained from Your Divine Son, that all the advocates of the Rosary shall have for intercessors the entire Celestial court during their life and at the hour of death. So, in this great battle for souls, let us arm ourselves with the power of the Rosary and the Holy Eucharist, wear the Miraculous Medal and the Scapular with faith, to save us from the eternal fires of hell.

Petition 13: We pray for the grace of fasting.

We pray for the grace of fasting not only from food, but from worldly and material things and offer them to You in sacrifice. Let our fasting from food and the materialism of this world be our offering for the atone-

ment of our sins and in reparation for the sins of mankind. Make us aware of our priorities in life, which is the salvation of souls, and the detachment from the materialism that this world falsely offers. All these hinder us from the love, knowledge and service of God.

Petition 14: We pray for the infirm, the aged, the sick and the dying.

Comfort and bless them in their last days. May they lift and offer their life's sufferings to God, receive the Last Sacraments, obtain pardon for their sins, and thereby merit the fullness of God's grace. In the end, may our Lord and His Blessed Mother take them safely home to their eternal abode in Heaven.

Petition 15: We pray for the poor, hungry & homeless.

We pray for the poor, the hungry, the homeless and in particular, the widows and the orphans, for it is especially in them that we see the Lord. Bless them in their needs, O Lord, and give them their means of support. We also pray for those who are in prison. Touch their hearts for total conversion and grant them Your peace. We pray that these beloved children of God may be spared from oppression, and may we never refuse their cry for help.

Petition 16: We pray for the poor souls in Purgatory.

We pray for the Poor Souls in Purgatory, especially for those who have stayed there the longest and who have no one to pray or make sacrifice for them. We also pray in particular for the souls of (here mention their names silently). May they, who suffer such dreadful torments, by our constant prayers be freed from their sufferings and finally be released from their pains. May they enjoy the beatitude of Heaven, where, prostrate before the Throne of God, they never cease to pray for those who helped them, until they see their benefactors safely in Heaven.

Petition 17: We pray for Priests, Religious, Missionaries.

We pray for our Priests, the Religious and Missionaries who have consecrated their lives to serve Your people spiritually, in love and diligence. May they be renewed in spirit and faithful to their vows and commitments to God. Keep them from sickness, temptation and harm, so that they could give more of themselves unselfishly and become more zealous to their apostolate.

Petition 18: We pray for all families.

We pray for all families and our own families too. May families always be together in love and in prayer. Let children honor and obey their parents and let parents love and protect their children the way God loves and protects His children. We pray that wives and children be spared from abuse and molestations of all sorts. May all families grow spiritually in unity and faith with Jesus and Mary, and may God bestow on us His blessings and His Divine Mercy and protect us from the terrible chastisement that is to come.

Petition 19: We pray for those on pilgrimage.

We pray for those who are on pilgrimage to see You. May all who seek You, Jesus, through our Mother Mary, find happiness and fulfillment in their search for You. We also pray for all travelers that they may be protected from harm and safely reach their destinations in Your grace.

Petition 20: We pray for our intentions.

We pray for our own intentions (silently pray for your personal intentions). We consecrate ourselves to You, O Lord, and we pray for Your grace and acceptance of all the intentions that with humility and in accordance to Your will, we have brought at the foot of Your altar today. We ask all these from the Father with the intercession of our Mother Mary, in Jesus' Most Holy Name.

Petition 21: We pray for healing.

Lord, look upon us with the eyes of Your mercy. May Your healing hands rest upon us, especially (name someone whom you are praying for). May your life giving powers flow into every cell of our body and into the depths of our souls: clearing, restoring, purifying us to wholeness and strength for service in Your Kingdom.

Petition 22: We pray for an indwelling of the Holy Spirit.

We pray for the indwelling of the Holy Spirit. Lord, Who are the only source of health and healing, the Spirit of calm and central peace of the Universe. Grant unto us such consciousness of Your indwelling Spirit and surrounding presence that we may always be in good health, strength and peace. Through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Petition 23: We pray for the restoration of our broken world.

O Loving Mother, we pledge ourselves to a more intensely Christian lifestyle. To a greater observance of the Laws of God; to be more conscientious in fulfilling the obligations of our state of life and to strive to be a source of healing in this broken world of ours.

Petition 24: We pray for self-dedication to our Lord.

We pray for self-dedication to our Lord, Jesus Christ. Lord Jesus, take all my freedom, my memory, my understanding and my will. All that I have and cherish and everything You have given me, I surrender them all to You, to be guided by Your will. Your grace and Your love are wealth enough for me.

Petition 25: We pray for a special intention.

O Sacred Heart of Jesus, I have asked for so many favors, but I earnestly implore this one (silently mention your intention). Take it and place it in Your Sacred Heart. When the Eternal Father sees it covered with Your Most Precious Blood, He will not refuse it. It will be no longer my prayers, but Yours. O Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place my trust in You. Let me never be confounded.

Petition 26: We pray for hope and consolation.

This day and every day of my life, and at the hour of my death; I commend my soul and body to You. I entrust all my hopes and consolations, all my trials and miseries in life, that through Your most Holy intercessions and Your merits, may my actions be disposed according to Your will and that of Your Divine Son.

Petition 27: We pray for the Church.

Glorious Father, we pray for Your Catholic Church. Fill it with Your truth. Keep it in Your peace. Where it is corrupt, reform it. Where it is in error, correct it. Where it is in want, provide for it. Where it is divided, reunite it, for the sake of Your Son, our Savior, Jesus Christ.

Petition 28: We pray for the consecration of our country.

We pray for the consecration of our country. O Mary, Virgin most powerful and Mother of Mercy, Queen of Heaven and refuge of sinners; we consecrate ourselves to your Immaculate Heart. We consecrate to you our being and our whole life, all that we have and all that we love. All that we are, we give our bodies, our hearts, our souls to you, and we give our homes and families, and our country. We desire that all that is in us and around us to belong to you and may share in the benefit of your motherly benediction.

Petition 29: We pray for the triumph of the Sacred & Immaculate Hearts.

We pray for the triumph of the most Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Sorrowful and Immaculate Heart of Mary. Dear most Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, reign in our hearts, in our homes, in the families, in the Church, in the lives of all the faithful, in the hearts of those who do not know you yet, in all the nation and in all the world.

Petition 30: We pray for dedication to our Blessed Mother.

We pray for the dedication to our Blessed Mother Mary. Sovereign Virgin Mary, Mother of the Living God, because you have delivered Him, our Lord Jesus Christ, pray for us sinners, so that He may pardon us, save us from the wicked enemy and grant us Eternal Glory. Glory be forever the most Sacred Passion and Death of our Lord, Jesus Christ.

Petition 31: We pray for faith, hope and love (charity).

We pray for the faith, hope and charity. My God, I believe in You because you are Truth itself. My God, I hope in You because you are infinitely Good. My God, I love You because You are infinitely deserving of all my love and I love my neighbor as myself.

Petition 32: We pray for the reparation of sinners.

We pray for the reparation of sinners. O Jesus, through the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I offer You my prayers, my works and sufferings of this day. For all the intentions of the Sacred Heart, in union with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass throughout the world. In reparation for sins, for the intentions of all my friends and associates, and in particular for the intentions of our Holy Father.

Petition 33: We pray for the Angels at Mass.

We pray for the Holy Angels to be at Mass for us in our absence. O Holy Angel at my side, please go to Church for me. Kneel in my place where I desire to be at the offertory. In my stead, take all I am and offer it as a sacrifice upon the Altar Throne. At the Holy Consecration's bell, adore with Seraph's love, my Jesus hidden in the Host come down from Heaven above.

Petition 34: We pray for Angels to pray for our friends.

Pray and ask our Holy Angels to pray for our dear ones and the unloved. Dear Holy Angels, pray for our loved ones and those who caused our grief, so that the Blood of Jesus may cleanse all hearts and bring suffering souls relief.

Petition 35: We pray for the reception of Holy Communion.

We pray when we receive Communion. Dear Holy Angel, bring My Lord to me, that His sweet Heart may rest in me, His Temple. May the Body of Christ save me and the Blood of Christ inebriate me and the Water from the side of Christ, wash me.

Petition 36: We pray for the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Pray for dedication to the most Sacred Heart of Jesus. Dear Jesus, with my heart full of desire for You, I invite You to come into my heart, into my soul, into my life, into my past and into my present. Come and take first place in my heart. From now on, it belongs only to you.

Petition 37: We pray that Jesus would give Himself to us.

We pray, dear Jesus, that You give all of Yourself to me. Dear Jesus, open Yourself up to me wholeheartedly without ever holding anything back, in the same way I give my heart to You, as it is now. You desire that my heart be completely clean and free, merciful, joyful, full of love, patient and generous. You wish my heart to become like Yours. Jesus, I too desire this.

Petition 38: We pray to thank You, Lord Jesus.
