**Raccolta #122:** O God, who didst appoint Thine only-begotten Son to be the Saviour of mankind and didst command His Name to be called Jesus; mercifully grant that we may enjoy the vision of Him in Heaven, whose holy Name we venerate on earth. Through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.

An indulgence of 5 years. A Plenary Indulgence once a month on the usual conditions, if this prayer is said devoutly every day (S. P. Ap., Nov. 22, 1934).

### Raccolta #119:

Blessed be the most holy Name of Jesus without end!

The faithful who recite five times the doxology "Glory be to the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning is now and ever shall be, world without end" together with the [above] ejaculation may gain: An indulgence of 300 days (Pius X, Audience Nov. 19, 1906, Exhib. Nov. 26, 1906).

## Raccolta #118:

The faithful who, during the month of January, perform some special act of devotion in honor of the holy Name of Jesus are granted:

An indulgence of 7 years once on any day of the month; a Plenary Indulgence on the usual conditions, if this act of devotion is repeated daily for the entire month (Apostolic Brief, Dec. 21, 1901; S. P. Ap., Jan. 2, 1933).

#### Raccolta #120:

The faithful who, after confession and Communion, visit some church or oratory, public or even semipublic (in the case of those who may lawfully use the latter), on the Feast of the most holy Name of Jesus and pray for the intentions of the Sovereign Pontiff may gain:
